

Water supply shortages, growing communities, and changing water needs together mean that a number of Olivenhain Municipal Water District projects are planned or underway to ensure reliable water service to current and future customers.

- **Village Park Recycled Water Project** (Bids due January 22, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.)
- OMWD is expanding recycled water service to portions of the Village Park community of the city of Encinitas to serve the greenbelts, HOA-maintained areas, schools, and golf course. OMWD is collaborating with San Elijo Joint Powers Authority on this project. The project consists of approximately 6.5 miles of 4- to 12-inch recycled pipeline and an owner-furnished packaged pump station. Attendance at one of the two Pre-Bid Conference meetings is mandatory.
