An **IMPORTANT PROJECT** is Starting in Your Neighborhood

OMWD is proactive in repairing or removing aging water infrastructure. In 1978, OMWD installed the Morning Sun Pressure Reducing Station at the intersection of Morning Sun Drive and Rancho Santa Fe Road, which is nearing the end of its useful life.



This fall, OMWD plans on removing the now-obsolete pressure reducing station, which will include removal of the existing steel pipeline feeding the station, demolition and removal of the existing vault lid, removal of the upper half of the vault walls and internal piping, installation of 95 feet of 24-inch diameter water pipeline, and replacement of the existing fire hydrant. The project should be completed within 90 days of commencement.

OMWD is working in conjunction with the City of Encinitas to minimize impacts during the city's street improvement project occurring in the same vicinity as the pressure reducing station and pipeline work.

What should I expect?

- Construction will begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m.
- Construction is anticipated to start in the coming weeks.
- Work trucks in the area during construction hours.
- Temporary adjustment of traffic flow on Morning Sun Drive.
- Temporary shut-off of water service at certain homes may be necessary. Affected customers will be notified at least 48 hours prior to any interruption in service.
- No noticeable change to your water pressure after work is complete.
