Key Duties and Responsibilities:

Duties include laying and joining pipe; breaking out pavement for installations; repairs of mains and services; installation and maintenance of customer meters; routine maintenance on equipment and facilities. Operates a variety of equipment including backhoe, earthmover, trucks, compressors, pneumatic hammers, drills and related machinery, welders and hand tools. Participates in training on all procedures and operation of machinery, vehicles, and equipment. Performs administrative work as required. This position requires the ability to be "on-call", working evenings, weekends, and holidays.

Minimum Qualifications:

High School diploma or equivalent; valid California driver's license and proof of insurability; Standard First Aid and CPR certifications are required. Minimum of one year of experience laying pipe and related materials. Basic familiarity with the following: electrical, plumbing, welding, heavy equipment operation, and landscaping. State of California Water Distribution Operator D1 certification is preferred at hire and required within one (1) year of appointment.
